IMPORTANT DATES & CANDIDATES FILED

Friday, October 27th

The deadline to PRE-REGISTER to vote for the Regular City Election is 5:00 P.M. on this day. This applies to registration in person (including registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. After today, a person may register to vote at the Auditor's Office and vote an absentee ballot that same day. The process is the same as for registering to vote on Election Day and specific documentation must be provided. If possible, please register before Election Day.

Friday, November 3rd

Deadline to Request Absentee Ballot to be mailed for the Regular City Election is at 5:00 p.m.

ELECTION DAY

Tuesday, November 7th

Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Polling Places are as follows:

Red Oak Gold Fair Building (Precinct 1 or Ward 1), Red Oak Fire Station (Precinct 2 or Ward 2), First Christian Church (Precinct 3 or Ward 3), Elliott Community Building (Precinct 4), Grant Fire Station (Precinct 5), Stanton Fire Department (Precinct 6) and Villisca Community Building (Precinct 7)

Those requesting Absentee Ballots by mail should complete their requests as soon as possible and return them to the Auditor's Office. Absentee Ballot requests will be filled as soon as the Ballots are available.
