September 12, 2017

IMPORTANT DATES

Friday, September 1, 2017

The deadline to PRE-REGISTER to vote for the School or College Election is 5:00 P.M. on this day. This applies to registration in person (including registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. After today, a person may register to vote at the Auditor's Office and vote an absentee ballot. The process is the same as for registering to vote on Election Day and specific documentation must be provided. If possible, please register before Election Day.

September 4, 2017

The Auditor's Office will be closed for Labor Day.

September 8, 2017

The deadline to Request an Absentee Ballot by Mail is 5:00 P.M.

September 12, 2017--ELECTION DAY

Voters may vote by absentee ballot IN-PERSON at the Auditor's Office from 8:00-11:00 A.M. on Election Day.

POLLS OPEN 12:00 P.M.(Noon) to 8:00 P.M.
